Apprenticeship training will soon be in recess for the summer and the Training Center will be available to do Journeyman Training Classes. With the need for any specialized training, in conjunction with our regularly offered Journeyman Classes, we are going to do training as we did last summer. We will be offering classes "on-demand". This means that you should call in and sign up for the classes you desire to take and when we have enough Journeymen to hold the class we will notify you of the starting time. Any desired or needed classes not listed below, please contact Dan Smith and we will try to provide those classes as well. This will allow us to be flexible in scheduling the building and thus allow us to have as many classes as possible.

Some of the classes we would like to offer are:

Orbital Tube Welding

20 hour course

Four evenings and one Saturday

Minimum students: 5

Description: Fundamentals of orbital welding using Arc 107 and 207 machines. Will include practical hands on pipe facing and welding. Also weld schedule development. Calculator and notebook required. Course will include the UA 18A orbital weld certification.

PVDF and Poly-Pro fusion

4-6 hour course

Evenings and/or Saturdays

Minimum students: 10

Description: Fundamentals of Poly-Pro and PVDF fusion. Manufacturers certification included.

OSHA 10 Hour Construction Safety & Health

12 hour course

Four evenings

Minimum students: 8

Description: OSHA Construction Safety and Health Outreach Certification, including such areas as Confined Space Entry, Trenching and Excavation, Lockout/Tag out, Personal Protective Equipment, Fire Safety, Electrical Safety and other topics.

Medical Gas Certification

40 hour course

Evenings and/or Saturdays

Minimum students: 10

Description: A forty hour course of instruction covering medical gas installation requirements (required under the International Plumbing Code) and ASME Section 9 Brazing Certification. Written and practical (brazing).

Pipe and Tube Bending plus Associated Math

15 hour course

Evenings and/or Saturdays

Minimum students: 8

Description: Fundamentals of Pipe and Tube Bending and Related Mathematics with hands-on practical application.

Refrigeration UA Star Certification Test Preparation

18-20 hour course

Evenings and/or Saturdays

Minimum students: 8

Description: UA Star Certification Test Preparation class covers the necessary points needed to pass the Certification Exam.

Air Flow Balancing

3-9 hour course

One to three evenings
